



***D*Estination: Space Exhibit
Celebrating Delaware's Contributions to
Space Exploration**

To celebrate the anniversary of the Apollo 11 moon landing, Delaware Humanities is developing a traveling exhibit on the history of Delaware's contributions to space exploration. While mainly focusing on the Apollo and shuttle programs, this exhibit will also include the stories of the first Delaware astronomers and even current research being conducted in the state.

The exhibit will be available from April 2019 through March 2020. The exhibit is ten (10) retractable banners and requires approximately 350 linear inches (the exhibit, however, does not have to be presented in a linear format). If the exhibit size is too large but your organization is interested in hosting, please contact Delaware Humanities to discuss options.

The exhibit is free for any Delaware organization (libraries, museums, schools, cultural centers, and so forth) to borrow. Priority will be given to organizations that do not charge admission. The exhibit can be borrowed for one month (30 days) to two months (60 days).

The Exhibit Host will be required to:

- Offer one free public program during the time they host the exhibit. Programs can include but are not limited to film screenings, lectures, literary discussions, children's programming, and so forth.
- Sign an Exhibition Agreement.
- Complete and return an Exhibition Final Report (which will be supplied with the Exhibition Agreement before the hosting period).
- Credit Delaware Humanities in advertisements, publications, and at related events as the exhibit sponsor. Use of Delaware Humanities' logo is also required.
- Transport the exhibit from their location to the next location.
- Send a representative to a meeting with other exhibit host organizations about the exhibits and additional available resources. The meeting will be held early March 2019.
